

The 4th International conference BCI: Science&Practice.Samara 2018 takes it place in Samara State Medical University on October 11-13. This one-of-a-kind Russian BCI dedicated annual conference is co-organized by the Innovation Cluster of Medical and Pharmaceutical Technologies of the Samara Region and IT Universe Ltd. The participants will have an opportunity to learn about the Samara Medical State University innovative infrastructure while visiting the R&D manufacturing technopark and the Centre of Advanced Studies.
