3| Exposure

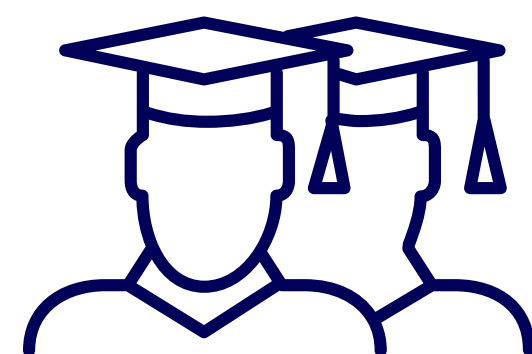
SIMS is a unique chance for you to share your research results with people working on the same issues.

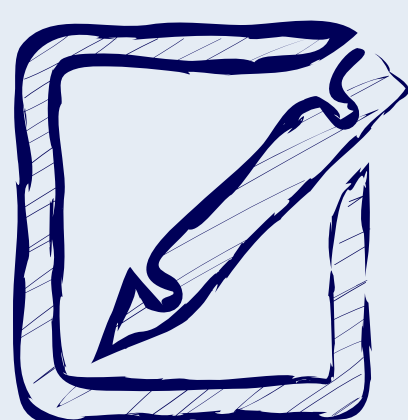

A conference participant has the right to submit **only one paper** for publication in which they are the author and **no more than 3 articles** in which they are a co-author. The maximum number of authors (together with co-authors) per article is three. The Organizing Committee emphasizes that **scientific supervisors and specialists older than 35 years cannot be co-authors of the works.**



Technical requirements for the article

The recommended size of the original article is **3-5 pages**. For texts, formulas and tables, use the Microsoft Word editor by Windows. Text editor features: all fields - 2 cm each; font – Times New Roman, size – 14; line spacing – 1.5; alignment justified; paragraph indent 1 cm; sheet orientation - portrait. Pictures made in MS Word are **not accepted**. All the pictures and tables should be numbered and provided with names or captions.

Title: (in capital letters, bold font, alignment: centered) indicate the **TITLE OF THE ARTICLE**; in the next line (bold italic font, alignment: right) - **full name of the author** of the article; in the next line (italic font, alignment: right) - academic title, academic degree, name of the university (institution), city, position, place of work, city (no abbreviations are allowed); in the next line (italic font, right alignment) - E-mail for contacts. If there are several authors, the information is repeated for each author.

The abstract should be no more than 600 characters (including spaces).

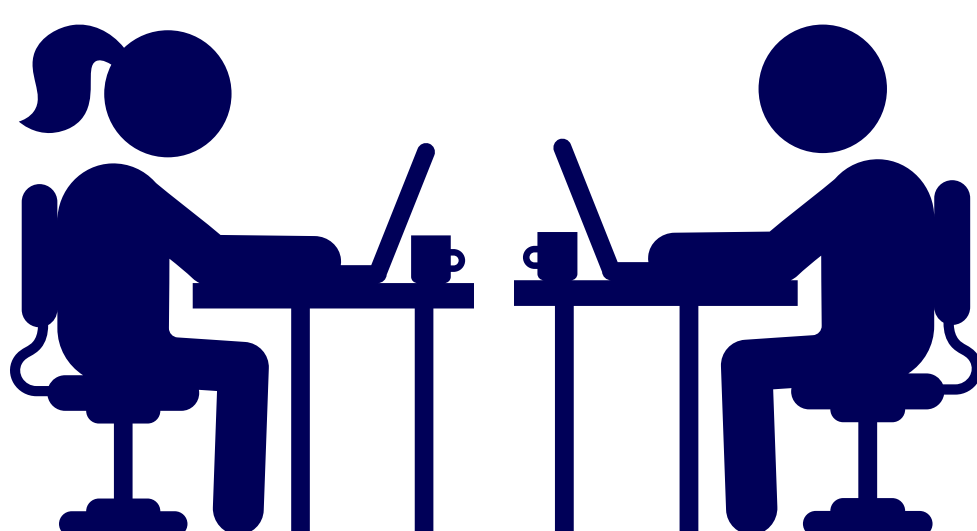
Keywords (bold italic font) should be given in Russian and English, separated from each other by a semicolon.

After skipping 1 line - **the text of the article**, which should include the following sections: introduction, aim of the study, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion.

After skipping 1 line - “**References**” (in alphabetical order, with continuous numbering, designed in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5 – 2008) (see the example below).

Title, abstract, keywords in English: the same information is repeated in English.

References in the text should be numbered in square brackets (E.g.: [3]) according to the number from the list of references.



Requirements for the e-Poster

The e-poster (electronic poster) should be submitted in .ppt format using Microsoft Power Point 1997-2003 and above, saved in a 2003-compatible format. The presentation should be in one file with a volume of 1 page, maximum size – 2 MB, horizontal orientation, the size: 140 cm (width) x 79 cm (height).

For a poster you should:

- indicate the title of the report (64-70 point size), names of the authors of the report, as well as the name of the organization where the study was performed on top of the poster;
- divide the entire text into 5 main sections according to the ones you have in your abstract/article: introduction (relevance), aim of the study, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion;
- choose a plain background without patterns (please, do not use dark colors for the background);
- use easy-to-understand, easy-to-read text (it is better to use standard Arial or TimesNewRoman fonts with a size of at least 20-24 points); use spaces between paragraphs, simple paragraph headings (so that your poster is easier to read);
- present information in a form convenient for visual perception: frameworks, drawings, graphs, tables, diagrams - clear and of good quality, plainly marked and signed.

The organizing committee of the conference reserves the right of technical editing or rejection of the materials that violate the requirements and are received after the deadline.

There will be a competition for the best works during the sessions of the conference. The best authors in each section will be awarded with valuable prizes.

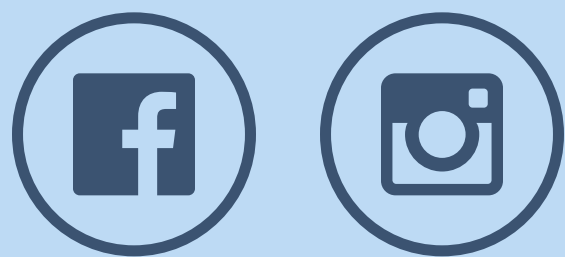
